

MAITLAND CAMERA CLUB 2018 PHOTOGRAPHY HUNT

The idea of this photography hunt is to look at each photographer's perspective on a set category. There are six categories in which you can enter up to two images per category. You must take these photos in the city of Maitland and within the boundaries designated. Once submitted in the allocated time frame, these photos will be judged in each category and a first place will be presented. This is a fun event and placings will not contribute to Maitland Camera Club's point score.

Dates

28th July - 12th August - Taking the photographs. The group will meet up at Maitland Train Station on Saturday, 28th July at 2pm to collect a map of the designated area and a list of the categories. For variation of photos, it is more desirable not to go in a big group, but please remember safety and have a mate with you. For those who can't make it that day, a map and list of categories will be available on Maitland Camera Club's website on 29th July. You have until 11.45pm on the 12th August to take your photos and submit them on-line.

12th August - Images need to be submitted on-line by 11.45pm on this date.

17th-20th August - Judge views photos and will select a winning entry for each category.

21st August - Showing of entries and presentation of awards at Maitland Camera Club. The judge, Kim Evans who is a well renowned local photographer and was a member of the AIPP for 25 years will be present on the night.

Boundaries

Hunter River, Ken Tubman Drive, New England Highway, traffic lights at the corner of High Street and New England Highway.

Terms and Conditions

1. You can enter up to two images per category. Entry into each category is optional.
2. EDI images only.
3. Entries must be submitted on-line via the Maitland Camera Club Website.
4. Image title should be the same as the file name as per MyPhotoClub website recommendations.
5. File size limits are the same as Maitland Camera Club standards, i.e. 1920 pixels wide x 1200 pixels high (when viewed with correct orientation) x 2mb file size and JPEG RGB format.
6. You must stay within the boundaries given.
7. Late entries will not be accepted.
8. First place of each category will receive a token gift and certificate.
